Dear Families of OLQA Students from the William Floyd School District:

Like you, we have been trying to keep as up to date as possible with the situation regarding transportation. At this time – Sunday, 9:00 p.m. – it does not look like there will be a resolution in time for Tuesday morning.

We are going to put the following plan in place:

- Students from the William Floyd School District may be dropped off at Our Lady Queen of Apostles beginning at 7 a.m. beginning on Tuesday.
- Students may also remain after school until 1 p.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday and 4 p.m. on Thursday and Friday.

If you are going to drop your child off early or wish them to stay late, you must email Mrs. Halversen at gshalversen@olqany.org by 7 p.m. on Monday evening. This will allow us to put enough personnel in place on Tuesday morning and afternoon.

If you are going to drop off your child and/or pick them up at the regular school times, you must use the Main Entrance of OLQA, located on St. John Place. You **may not** drop off your child at the present bus-drop off location on Ocean Avenue. The same direction applies for pick up at regular dismissal time.

While these efforts do not take away the stress or the burden of limited transportation, I hope it provides some relief in these days.

I encourage you to reach out to the William Floyd Transportation office for more specific details. You can contact them at 631.874.1305. As you know, OLQA has no control over school bus transportation. We will continue to monitor events and follow up as soon as we hear anything.
